## HEALTH AND GENETIC WARRANTY

The Breeder, Shady Brook Bernedoodles, certifies that your Bernedoodle puppy is in good health. Has been dewormed, dew claws removed, and has been given a thorough exam from a licensed veterinarian. The puppy is up to date on all vaccinations at time of possession (vaccination records provided). The buyer will be responsible for keeping all vaccinations current according to the guidelines of The American Veterinary Medical Association. Buyer has 3 days to take the Bernedoodle puppy to a veterinarian for an examination. If the Bernedoodle puppy is found to be in poor health, the buyer has the option of returning the puppy (at buyer's expense) to the seller for a full refund. Buyer will also need to provide a written statement from a licensed Veterinarian clearly stating defect or illness. If puppy is not evaluated in the 3 day period provided, the health warranty is void.

This warranty does not include any illness due to physical injury nor the ingestion of foreign objects, foods, or chemicals.

The Seller provides a two year warranty from date birth for any debilitating congenital defects. The following stipulations must be adhered to in order for a replacement to be made. Official reports from 2 unaffiliated veterinarians stating that, without a doubt, the puppy has a genetic defect that is debilitating must be sent to seller along with phone numbers of each vet's office. If the puppy should die, an autopsy **MUST BE DONE** by a licensed veterinarian stating the cause of death. The documentation must be forwarded to us before a determination will be made.

The Seller reserves the right to confirm (at cost of seller) the diagnosis with a veterinarian of their choice. This warranty applies only to the original buyer. Puppy replacement or refund of original purchase price is at seller's discretion.

We strongly encourage new owners to keep their Bernedoodle puppy at home until all vaccinations are complete, with the exception of veterinary appointments. We also suggest that the puppy be taken to veterinary appointments in a kennel, not allowed to walk around or interact with other animals or people aside from staff. We cannot control the exposure your puppy encounters after leaving here, but we have done everything possible to provide you the healthiest puppy by following those guidelines. Puppies sometimes get stressed when adopted and moved to their new home. This stress can be brought on due to the move, change of diet, too much handling, not enough quiet time, or not eating properly. This stress can also bring on things that are dormant such as, but not limited to; worms, ear mites, colds, hypoglycemia, coccidiosis, and/or giardiasis. These conditions are all treatable and do not warrant a replacement.

There is NO GUARENTEE on the COLOR or SIZE of puppy now or as an adult. Bernedoodles are subject to fading, a gene from the poodle that is unfortunately not something that can be tested for.

The following are NOT covered by this guarantee:

- Reimbursement for veterinary expenses.
- Reimbursement for any shipping transport/return.
- External parasites, such as ticks, fleas, or ear mites.

Internal parasites, such as intestinal worms, or their effects (almost every puppy has some sort of intestinal worms; although we have dewormed your puppy regularly, it only takes a few days for him/her to pick up another “batch”. That’s just a part of puppy hood, which is why a regular deworming schedule is recommended.) It is your ultimate responsibility to take good care of your puppy and provide adequate food, water, shelter, and veterinarian care.

Breeding Rights- This puppy is NOT being sold with breeding rights.

Buyer is aware that puppy is being sold as pet quality and as so releases seller from any liability related to the breeding of dog. If dog is breed in the future it will void Health and Genetic Warranty of dog.

*Please be aware that as a new puppy owner you share in the responsibility of helping prevent hip dysplasia, as it has been proven to be part heredity and increasingly environmental. We have bred this puppy based on sound stock. Through proper diet, proper exercise and quality living conditions, you can play an important role in helping your puppy grow into a healthy adult.*

If at any time the buyer determines that they are unable to keep the Bernedoodle puppy, the buyer will contact the seller to notify them. The buyer and seller together will determine how to rehome the dog. The buyer agrees to never place the Bernedoodle dog in a shelter, pound or like facility.

I, the Seller, do hereby agree to offer five (5) day health and one (1) year genetic warranty on this puppy.
